CSMA: THIS weekend, our parish, along with all other parishes in the diocese will conduct our Catholic Service & Ministry Appeal. The CSMA provides a convenient way for all of us, no matter what our time limitations, to take an active role in the mission of our diocesan Church. If you did not receive a pledge card in the mail or forgot to bring it, please use one of the envelopes that are available on the tables In the back of church. Please be as generous as you are able.

SEASON OF LENT: Extends from Ash Wednesday, March 6th to the Mass of the Lord’s Supper, April 18th inclusive. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday & all Fridays of Lent. Everyone 18 years of age & under 59 years of age is also bound to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On these 2 days of fast & abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. The other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one’s but altogether they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these 2 days, but liquids, including milk & fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the obligation of the law is modified. Because Lent is a special season for all Christians, we should not lightly excuse ourselves from these penitential practices. To completely disregard the law of fast & abstinence is seriously sinful.
