PRAYING THE PSALMS WITH JESUS THIS LENT: This week, connect Psalm 2:7 with Luke 3:22
 What does it mean to you to be a daughter or a son of God? Are you living like one?

SEASON OF LENT: Extends from Ash Wednesday, March 6th to the Mass of the Lord's Supper, April 18th inclusive. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday & all Fridays of Lent. Everyone 18 years of age & under 59 years of age is also bound to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On these 2 days of fast & abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. The other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's but altogether they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these 2 days, but liquids, including milk & fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the obligation of the law is modified. Because Lent is a special season for all Christians, we should not lightly excuse ourselves from these penitential practices. To completely disregard the law of fast & abstinence is seriously sinful.

SISTER PARISH IN GUATEMALA: Last week we received an email from P. Jose Benedicto Moscoso from our Sister Parish in Guatemala saying he had received a total of \$1,959.00 from the parishioners of St. Rose during the months of July to December 2018. He used \$306.41 of the money to pay the diocese & seminary & \$1652.59 for food, vehicle maintenance and maintenance on the parochial house. He would like to Thank and Bless the parishioners & pastor of St. Rose.

BLACK AND INDIAN COLLECTION: Today our parish will take up the 135th Black & Indian Collection. Your support of this collection helps build the Church in African American, Native American & Alaska Native communities from coast to coast, including the Belleville Diocese, which received \$132,000 last year.
